



**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE MANagements OF ENGINEERING AND PHARMACY COURSES
FOR THE YEAR 2014-15 REGARDING ADMISSIONS TO CATEGORY-B SEATS**

1. The user id and password of ePASS will be provided by email and through mobile to respective colleges for opening the college login.
2. Every college has to pay Rs.5,000/- towards processing fee to CGG.
3. Information on Application/Registration fee to be entered by the college within the prescribed last date otherwise a minimum of Rs.500/- will be fixed as the said fees.
4. After last date the college can download all registered applications and a combined list of applications received in person and also downloaded from the portal (one select list) shall be prepared and uploaded to the portal by the managements.
5. The system also will generate college merit list of applicants for admissions.
6. Selection list for admission (course wise) be prepared by the managements and it shall be validated by APSCHE.
7. Interviews will be conducted if necessary by the managements to finalize the admission lists.
8. Shall follow strictly the prescribed schedule of admissions announced by APSCHE.
9. Admission lists for approval of the Competent Authority shall be submitted separately for Engineering and Pharmacy courses.
10. Hard copies of the original paper notification issued concerned to Category-B admissions shall be submitted to APSCHE.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS SPECIFIC TO THE MANagements:

- The Colleges who made irregular admissions for the academic year 2013-2014 and paid penalty of Rs.13,000/- per seat for ratification are hereby informed not to fill up equal no of seats in Cat 'B' admissions in that respective branch as per undertaking given by said management, who obtained G.O. for ratification.
- Candidates who possess mathematics at 10+2 level (or) passed the Bridge course in Mathematics are only eligible for Bio-Technology Course.
- Candidates are informed that the Pharmacy council of India vide Ref. No: 14-2/2009-PCI-10834-12152, dt: 17/07/2009 has not approved Intermediate equivalent

programs of one year duration such as NOS, APOSS for admission into Pharmacy courses for the purpose of Registration as pharmacist.

- NRI students shall be given admission only in the colleges wherein NRI scheme is permitted by AICTE for the current academic year.
- Foreign Nationals are not eligible for admission into Category 'B' Quota.
- No proposals submitted after the stipulated cutoff date i.e., for approval of Competent Authority shall be accepted under any circumstances, and the College Management will be held responsible for the ratification of the students admissions.
